About This Project

Halton Region is making improvements to Trafalgar Road (Regional Road 3) from Leighland Ave to north of Hays Blvd, Wards 5 & 6 in the Town of Oakville. This project will address future traffic demands and provide safe travel options for motorists, pedestrians and cyclists.

To safely accommodate construction for road widening, the sidewalk along the east side of Trafalgar Road will be closed between Iroquois Shore Road and Upper Middle Road (see page 2 of this notice for map). Details of this sidewalk closure are as follows:

Notice of Sidewalk Closure– White Oaks Boulevard

Closure: Sidewalk along the east side of Trafalgar Road.

Limits: From Iroquois Shore Rd to Upper Middle Road, as shown on **page 2 of this notice**.

Timing: August 2020 to July 2021.

Detour Route: For pedestrian access to Trafalgar Road, please use the intersection at White Oaks Blvd and Trafalgar Road to cross street and use west sidewalk. The pedestrian detour route can be found on **page 3 of this notice**.

All Oakville Transit and GO Transit bus stops along the east side of Trafalgar Road are being relocated to the nearest available intersection. These will remain accessible throughout this phase of construction.



LIMITS OF TRAFALGAR ROAD SIDEWALK CLOSURE


